Once again the Association of School Councils for FFCA has chosen to support the Calgary Food Bank. Our partnership with the Food Bank is giving us a chance to give back to the great city we live in and help those in need during some of the most critical times of the year. Last year, families, staff, central office and Board Members donated 6,812 units of non-perishable items which equated to approximately 5,715 pounds of generosity.

Our FFCA goal will be to collect one non-perishable food item per person at FFCA – that equates to 3,737 units of food.

In keeping with the tradition, we are encouraging every principal, teacher, staff member, and student from our seven campuses along with every board member, central office staff member to bring at least one food bank donation.
